**Subject:** **Velocity Computer Resource Usage Update**

**Reason:** Some versions of the Velocity PCIe card request more memory from the computer resources than required during boot.

If multiple cards were installed, sometimes during boot the computer would halt with a message stating “not enough memory was available”.

Typically, this would not occur unless more than 3 Velocity cards were installed in the computer system.

**Exception(s):** If only 1 or 2 Velocity card(s) are installed in the computer system, there will be no issues and this bulletin can be disregarded.

**Solution:** The correct amount of memory required has been programmed into the latest release of Velocity F/W products and this issue has been resolved – allowing up to 15 cards in a system.
